

2006 SOL GOLF TOURNAMENT NOTES

FIVE PONDS GOLF CLUB



The course rating for Tuesday will be 71.5 for the men. Based on the 16 above course rating requirement to qualify for Districts, the men will have to shoot an 88 to qualify. The top 38 scores (25 teams X 1.5) will qualify.

The course superintendent and I will make a decision on Tuesday morning as to whether we will play the ball down or not. As Fred toured the course on Tuesday, he could see some areas where even rolling the ball wouldn't help much; however, the course has done a great job of marking "ground under" and "free-drop" areas.

The pin locations will be marked with [red \(forward\)](#), [white \(middle\)](#) and [blue \(back\)](#) flags.

There are several "environmental areas" on the course marked by yellow ropes. The holes with "environmental areas" are #6, #8, #9, #12 and #15. There will be "free-drop" areas marked with white circles [on holes #8, #12 and #15](#). [If a player hits into any other environmental area they receive two club-length relief with no penalty.](#)

The range, which comes into play on #10 and #18 is out of bounds. [A white OB line continues from the fence to the tip of the driving range tees](#). [If a player has a ball on the practice green, please seek relief before hitting it.](#)

The course has [several man-made objects including a pump house and a couple electrical boxes](#). We will be playing this as a "free-drop" within the line of sight, no nearer the hole. The course is saying that you can actually move the ball right or left or back as far as you want within the line of sight, no nearer the hole.

We will need spotters on holes #4, #8, #9, #12, #15 and #16 to help move play along. In addition, the monitors for each group would help by "fore caddying" as much as possible.

Remind the players, when in doubt about a ruling...play a provisional and we'll figure it out at the clubhouse.

If and when a playoff is needed, we will play holes #10, #11, #12, #15, #16, #17 and #18, in that order. We will tee-off from #10, #12, #15, #16 and #18.

Registration will begin at 8:00 am on the side deck. The meeting will be at 8:40 am in the area around the side deck.

William Tennent's High School golf team will be providing complimentary coffee, bagels, etc. prior to the start of the tournament. The snack bar will be open during the round for students to purchase drinks, food, etc.

The driving range and putting greens will be available prior to the tournament. Range balls cost \$5 for 90 balls.
