Drama ['dræmə] noun: an exciting, emotional, or unexpected series of events or set of circumstances : a *golf match drama* | : an afternoon of high drama at LuLu Country Club. This is what unfolded last Friday afternoon when PW went on the road to face Upper Dublin, the only league team to defeat PW this season. Despite being eliminated from the league title race the day before (3-shot loss at Upper Merion), the Cardinals showed up with their "A" game. Upper Dublin's number one, Scott Dunnam, started his round with two straight birdies. **GAME ON.** Zach Pogust led the PW attack with three solid pars on his final three holes, while hitting 8 greens in regulation, en-route to a two-over par 37. Alfred Garvey's 25-foot birdie putt on the par four, 9th hole, was also a key shot for the Colonials. In addition, seniors Kenny Yanni & Nick Jefferies both came in with solid rounds of 40 & 41, respectively.

But the real drama came on the very last hole of the last group. Word had spread around the green that UD's Andrew Klazmer needed just a par to finish with a 39 and give the Cardinals a one-shot victory. His approach shot to green sailed 25 feet past the pin. His birdie putt coming back stopped five feet short of the hole. Hiding in the shadows was PW sophomore Zak Glaser, whose chip shot had nestled 4-feet below the pin. Word was that Zak needed his bogie putt to finish with a 41. That meant that if both golfers made their putts, both teams would be deadlocked at 201 apiece. Klazmer let his putt roll only to see it slide left, curl around the cup, and slide out. That meant Glaser's putt was for the win, *not a tie*. He calmly stood confident over the putt and put it in... "dead center".

Earlier in the week, PW hosted Methacton, a strong contender for the PAC-10 title, at The ACE Club. The Warriors, loaded with tons of experience (six seniors), had seven golfers all shoot 42 or better to defeat the Colonials 196-202. Low score for the Colonials were Zach Pogust (37) and Evan Beaty (39).

On Tuesday, PW defeated Upper Moreland 205-244 at Green Valley CC. The Colonials were led by Pogust (38), Carter Field (41), Kenny Yanni (41), Alfred Garvey (42), Zak Glaser and John Fritz (both 43's).

The PW V2 golf team, under the direction of Coach Kavanagh, remained undefeated with wins over Abington (223-257) and Wissahickon (240-245). Dom Aprile, Mike Caplan and Dave Pontari all shot 44's against the Ghosts.

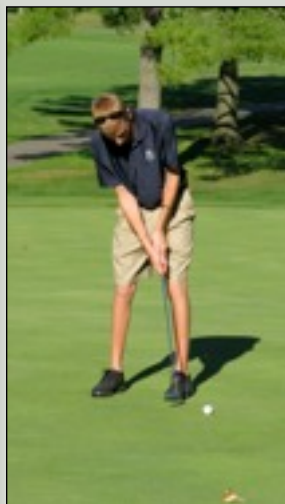

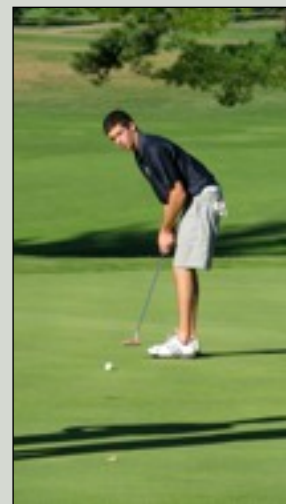
